



Helijet Begins Temporary Scheduled Passenger Service Between Squamish and Downtown Vancouver Due to Sea-to-Sky Highway Closure

Richmond, BC (July 31, 2008): Helijet International will offer scheduled passenger and cargo helicopter service between Squamish Airport and Vancouver Harbour Heliport commencing Friday, August 1st through Monday, August 4th inclusive.

One-way fare will be \$80 +GST.

"This fare is the lowest possible that we can offer, as Helijet is seeking only to recover its operating costs for this temporary service," said Danny Sitnam, President and CEO of Helijet. "We are pleased to be in a position to help people who really need to leapfrog this road closure by offering this air link."

- A Sikorsky 12-passenger helicopter will make 8 to 10 return flights daily between Vancouver Harbour Heliport and Squamish Airport. (Flight schedule is available for viewing on Helijet's website).
- Travel time is expected to be about 20 minutes for each way.
- Southbound commuters may park at Squamish Airfield's designated overnight parking lot and fly to Vancouver.
- Northbound commuters depart from Helijet's Downtown Harbour Heliport/terminal.
- Helijet will be placing approximately 240 seats daily into service between both destinations.
- Helijet representatives will be on site at both landing points to assist passengers boarding their flights.
- Rental cars and ground transportation available at Vancouver Heliport and Squamish Airport.
