Thank you for your interest and entry into the **59th Annual Squamish Days Loggers Sports Festival Parade**, taking place on **Sunday, July 31, 2016**. We are asking that participants exceed their usual enthusiasm and create the best floats and parade entries yet! There are no entry fees, and the parade is a great way to advertise your business, club, association, or community. Below is important information regarding the day of the parade.

The **parade staging area** is located at the dryland sort on Loggers Lane in downtown Squamish. **Entrants should plan to be at the staging area no later than 9.00am**, where you will be given further instructions and judging will begin.

All entrants must register at the Squamish Emergency Program Command Vehicle (no exceptions)

Directions:

From Highway 99, turn onto Cleveland Avenue – towards downtown Squamish
Follow Cleveland Avenue until the end, turn left onto Vancouver Avenue
Cross the railroad tracks – Vancouver Avenue becomes Loggers Lane
The dryland sort is on the left, just beyond the Squamish Yacht Club

The **parade route** follows Cleveland Avenue back to Pemberton Avenue and will end in the parking area behind the Bank of Montreal. There are no entry fees and it is great free advertising for your business, club, or association. Please return your completed entry form to us no later than July 19th, 2015.

Let's make this the most fun and biggest parade we can! Please note, the parade will be held rain or shine. The enclosed entry form should be returned to us no later than **Friday, July 22nd, 2016**.
