



# SQUAMISH DAYS PARADE INFORMATION

Thank you for your interest and entry into the **60<sup>th</sup> Annual Squamish Days Loggers Sports Festival Parade**, taking place on **Sunday, August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2017**.

We are asking that participants exceed their usual enthusiasm and create their best floats and parade entries yet! There are no entry fees, and the parade is a great way to advertise your business, club, association, or group, and to spread some community spirit.

In celebration of the 60th Anniversary of the Squamish Days Loggers Sports Festival, a distinguished panel of judges will select the Top 3 Parade entries who will be awarded with the prize money breakdown noted below, for donation towards a local Squamish non-profit or charity (conditions apply) in their name:

1st Place - \$500 donation

2nd Place - \$300 donation

3rd Place - \$200 donation

Selected recipients must be a Squamish based non-profit or charity, and their funds or services must benefit Squamish directly. All winners must submit their charity of choice for approval to the Squamish Days Loggers Sports Committee.

## Event Information:

The **parade staging area** is located at the dryland log sort in downtown Squamish, **Entrants should plan to be at the staging area no later than 9.00am**, where you will be given further instructions and judging will begin. **All entrants must register at the Squamish Emergency Program Command Vehicle** (no exceptions).

## Directions:

From Highway 99, turn onto Cleveland Avenue – towards downtown Squamish  
Follow Cleveland Avenue until the end, turn left onto Vancouver Avenue  
Cross the railroad tracks – Vancouver Avenue becomes Loggers Lane  
The dryland sort is on the left, just beyond the Squamish Yacht Club

The **parade route** follows Cleveland Avenue back to Pemberton Avenue and will end in the parking area behind the Bank of Montreal.
